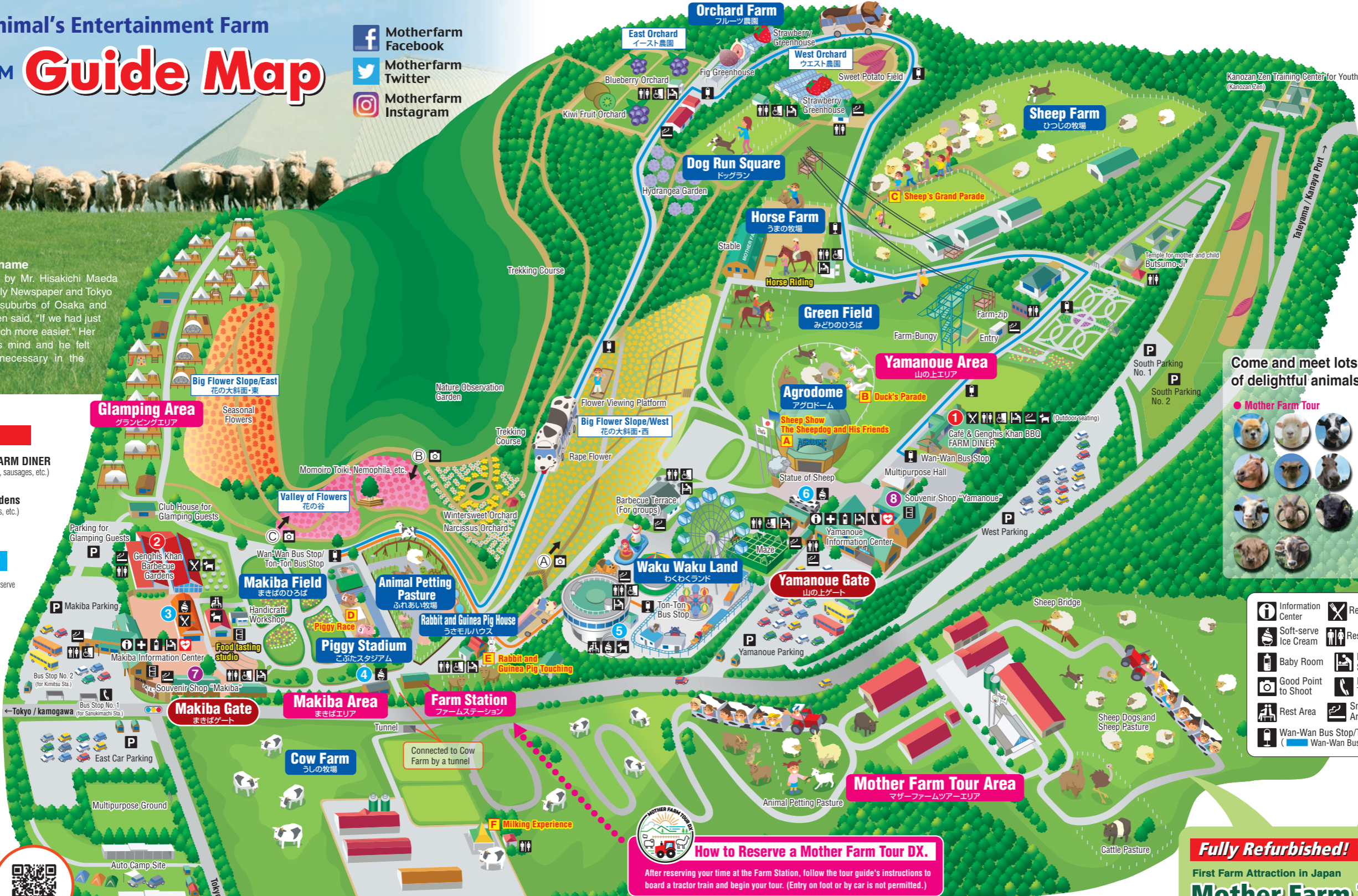

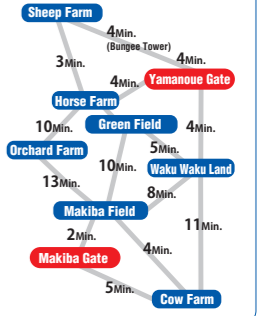

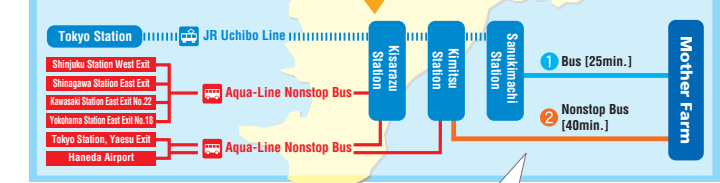

Seasonal Flowers

Fruits and Vegetables Picking

Fully enjoy nature's blessings at our blueberry farm, three-dimensional seven-stage hydroponic strawberry farm and elsewhere. Entry for fruits and vegetables picking is accepted in order of application and cannot be accepted when the number of applicants reaches the quota according to the estimated amount of harvest.

East Orchard/West Orchard (It varies depending on the day.)



Momoiro Toiki (petunia) 20,000 plants (early July to late September) Valley of flowers



Nemophila One million blossoms (mid-April to early May) Valley of flowers

- **Wintersweet** 100 trees (mid-January to mid-February)
- **Narcissus** 100,000 plants (late December to mid-February)
- **Hydrangea** 2,000 plants (mid-June to early July)

Please note that the flowering situation may vary depending on climatic conditions of the year.

Dog Run Area Horse Farm
